Treasurer's Report:

We will have some amount of profit from camp but details are not yet finalized. Insurance and rent have already been paid, so we will have a surplus.

Review Fall Vashon Retreat (November 7–9):

The written evaluations have not been tallied yet. We also received lengthy feedback from two leaders and a group of new leaders. We considered several changes in how future retreats could be organized. Several members spoke in support of our present method as generally being unique, well-received, and satisfying.

One concern was lack of a well-structured theme or wave-form to the entire weekend. After some discussion we realized we could ask the five poles to meet ahead of time and craft a coherent arc to the weekend. This would have to be done early enough for a flier to be created before the spring retreat.

Another concern was the balance of experienced and newer leaders. We could create some clearer expectations/guidelines (such as limiting non-certified leaders to one dance or only familiar dances), or we could allow for fluidity, intuition and inspiration by leaving the flow of each session up to the poles.

An afternoon session with one experienced leader's deep concentration was much appreciated and could be structured again.

Some of the wording on the flier and the evaluations should be updated.

Do we want to cap the number of attendees? We will need to consider that at a future meeting

Financial picture: Final bills, deposits and refunds are not all completed yet. Both income and expenses were higher, since we had 84 people, while last year we had 66 attendees. We will likely have a healthy profit after it is all calculated. We received \$1100 in donations and gave away eight scholarships at \$100 each. The held-over scholarship fund thus now comes to \$742.

Music Boshi: Hassan served in this role for the second time. This year most leaders had already selected their musicians, which worked well. An on-site person is useful for problem solving (replacements, last-minute requests) but does not need to organize for all the groups.
